- Provide information, instruction, training and supervision to employees, contractors and customers to ensure their safety.
- Establish measurable objectives and targets as part of the management system to pursue continued improvement aimed at eliminating work place injuries.
- Provide support and assistance to employees.

Responsibilities

The company's management is responsible for:

- The provision and maintenance of the workplace in a safe condition.
- Involvement in the development, promotion and implementation of health and safety policies and procedures.
- Training employees in the safe performance in their assigned tasks.
- Provision of resources to meet the health and safety commitment.

Employees are to:

- Follow all health and safety policies and procedures.
- Report all known or observed hazards to management.

Application of the Policy

This policy is applicable to all Doolans Heavy Haulage sites and to all its operations and functions including those situations where employees are required to work off site.

Consultation
